

Fabaceae (Pea Family)

Phenology: flowering March and April; fruiting April.

Management Responsibility: BLM (AZ Strip Field Office), AZ State Land Dept.

Notes: this species has been monitored since 1988; there is a conservation agreement and strategy being written; a Virgin drainage endemic.

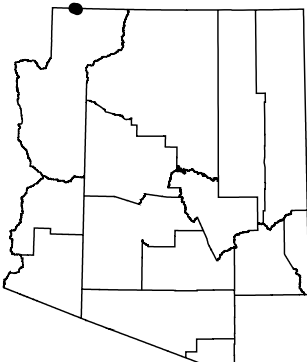

Habitat: Great Basin shrub communities, 2,700-2,800 ft (825-855 m) elevation. Substrate is well-drained shallow gravelly sandy loams; alluvial fans and rock outcrops.
