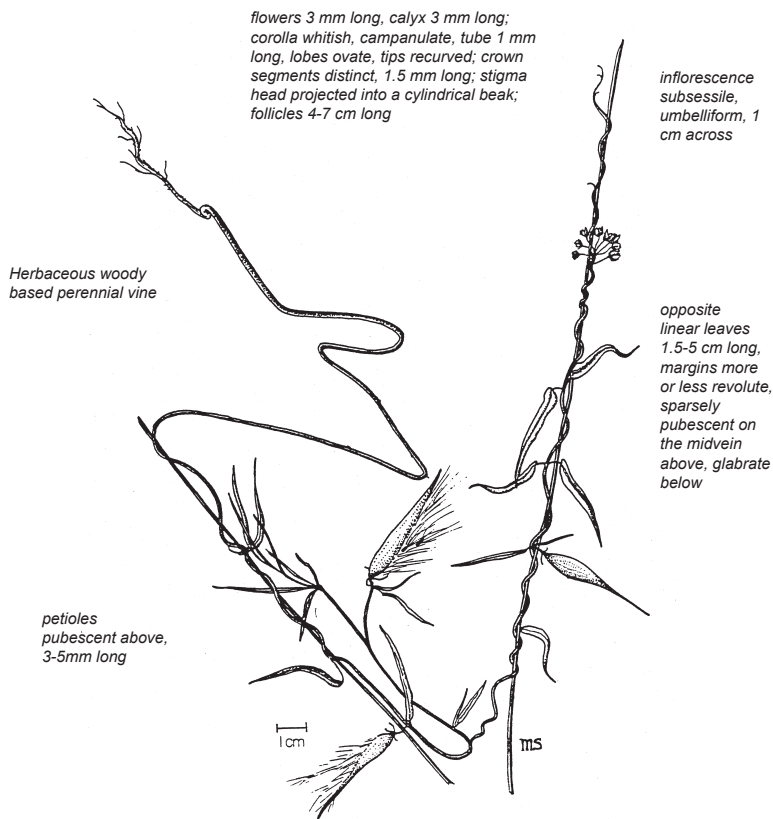


***Asclepiadaceae (Milkweed Family)***

Phenology: flowers in July through September, possibly October.

Management Responsibility: USFS (Coronado NF), BLM (Tucson Field Office), AZ State Land Dept.

Synonyms: *Cynanchum wigginsii* Shinnery, *Basistelma angustifolium* (Torrey) Bartlett.

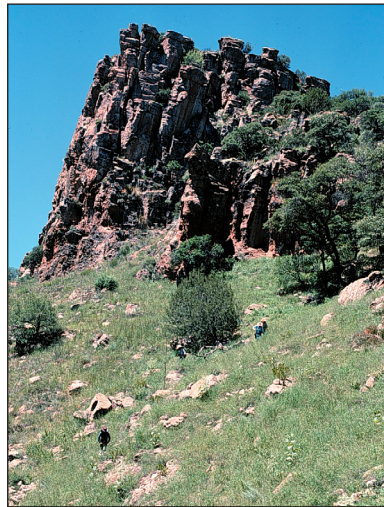

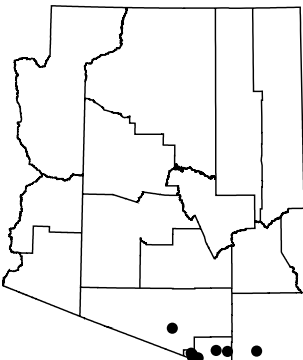

Metastelma mexicanum

Habitat: found growing on rocky slopes and canyons in oak woodlands. Plants often found growing underneath other shrubs and twining on grasses and shrubs in elevations ranging from 3,500-5,500 ft (1067-1676 m).
